

WHERE IN THE WORLD IS SANTA?

All your students have to do is guess where in the world Santa is. They'll get three clues to each destination. If they guess correctly on the first clue, they win three points. QUESTION 1

Clue 1:

This country is home to 130 volcanoes (both active and inactive).

(3 points)

Clue 2:

The population of this country is just over 334,000.

(2 points)

Clue 3:

The capital city is Reykjavik.

(1 point)

QUESTION 2

Clue 1:

This country's longest river is the Po.

(3 points)

Clue 2:

Over 3 million people live close to one of this country's three active volcanoes.

(2 points)

Clue 3:

This country's highest point is Mont Blanc.

(1 point)

QUESTION 3

Clue 1:

This country has the sixth largest population in Europe.

(3 points)

Clue 2:

This country is the only European country to share a border with an African country.

(2 points)

Clue 3:

This country covers the majority of the Iberian peninsula.

(1 point)

QUESTION 4

Clue 1:

This country is home to 140 glaciers.

(3 points)

Clue 2:

Approximately 20% of the Alps are in this country.

(2 points)

Clue 3:

This country shares borders with Italy, France, Germany, Austria and Liechtenstein.

(1 point)



QUESTION 5

Clue 1:

The Draa River is this country's longest.

(3 points)

Clue 2:

This country does not have a southernmost point.

(2 points)

Clue 3:

This country's highest peak is Toukbal, in the Atlas Mountains.

(1 point)

QUESTION 6

Clue 1:

10% of the world's active volcanoes are located in this country.

(3 points)

Clue 2:

Approximately 73% of this country is mountainous.

(2 points)

Clue 3:

This country experiences up to 1,500 earthquakes per year - some of which happen under the sea and can cause tsunamis.

(1 point)

QUESTION 7

Clue 1:

Part of this country lies on the Pacific Ring of Fire.

(3 points)

Clue 2:

The highest temperature ever recorded on Earth was recorded here.

(2 points)

Clue 3:

This country shares the world's longest bi-national land border with its northern neighbour.

(1 point)

QUESTION 8

Clue 1:

11 of the 17 tallest mountain peaks in the world are located on this country's western borders.

(3 points)

Clue 2:

This country's highest mountain is Mt. Everest.

(2 points)

Clue 3:

The longest river in Asia is located in this country.

(1 point)

QUESTION 9

Clue 1:

This country is just 50km wide at its narrowest point.

(3 points)

Clue 2:

Level land covers no more than 20% of this country's area.

(2 points)

Clue 3:

This country is the world's third largest producer of rice.
