HOLOCAUST TIMELINE



30th January 1933 Adolf Hitler, leader of the Nazi Party, elected chancellor of Germany.



15th November 1940 The Warsaw Ghetto is sealed off, with more than 400,000 Jews inside.



7th March 1941 German Jews ordered into forced labour.



20th January 1942 Wannsee Conference to organise the 'Final Solution'.



19th July 1942 Operation Reinhard ordered by Himmler – mass deportation of Polish Jews to extermination





The Nazis open their first concentration camps in Germany.




12th February 1940 First deportation of German Jews to Poland.



July 1941 SS Einsatzgruppen commits mass murder of Jews in occupied lands as it follows the advancement of the German Army.



January 1942 First gas chamber used to conduct mass murder at Auschwitz.



5th October 1942 Himmler orders all Jews imprisoned in concentration camps in Germany to be sent to Auschwitz and Majdanek.





15th September 1935

Nuremberg Laws decreed. Marriages and relationships between Jews and Germans outlawed. The laws also stripped German Jews of their citizenship and civil rights.



9th/10th November 1938 Kristallnacht – pogrom against Jews, perpetrated by SA paramilitary forces and German civilians.



1st September 1941 German Jews ordered to wear a yellow star.



3rd September 1941 First test of Zyklon-B gas at Auschwitz.



19th May 1943 Berlin is declared Judenfrei (free of Jews).



8th May 1944

Höss returns to Auschwitz to oversee the extermination of Hungarian Jews.



24th July 1944

Majdanek becomes the first concentration camp liberated by the Russians. Over 360,000 people had been murdered here.



4th August 1944

Anne Frank and her family are arrested in Amsterdam and sent to Auschwitz.

27th January 1945 Auschwitz is liberated by Russian troops.

30th April 1945 Hitler commits suicide in his bunker in Berlin.

7th May 1945 Germany surrenders unconditionally.



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
