Trophy got its name from the Calcutta Football Club. After the club was disbanded, the club funds, **270 silver rupee coins**, were melted down and made into a cup.



Made in India. Three **king cobras** form the handles. The domed lid is topped with an **elephant**.



The Calcutta Cup is awarded to the winners of the annual **England v Scotland** match. The match is a fixture in the annual **Six Nations** tournament.

The ground it's played at alternates each year, with **Twickenham** on odd years and **Murrayfield** on even.
