<b>12<sup>th</sup> June</b> Annelies Marie Frank is born in Frankfurt, Germany to Otto and Edith.	<b>30<sup>th</sup> January</b> Adolf Hitler becomes Chancellor of Germany. <b>23<sup>rd</sup> March</b> The Enabling Act gives Hitler powers to rule by decree. <b>Summer - February</b> The Frank family move to the Netherlands to escape growing persecution in Germany.	<b>1<sup>st</sup> September</b> Germany invades Poland. Two days later, Britain and France declare war on Germany and WW2 begins.	<b>10<sup>th</sup> May</b> Germany invades the Netherlands, Belgium and France.	<b>22<sup>nd</sup> -23<sup>rd</sup> February</b> The first deportation of Dutch Jews.	<b>3<sup>rd</sup> May</b> The introduction of the yellow star to identify Jews in the Netherlands. <b>12<sup>th</sup> June</b> Anne Frank receives a diary for her birthday. <b>5<sup>th</sup> July</b> Margot Frank, Anne's older sister, receives a call-up notice from the Nazis to work in a labour camp. The next day, the Frank family go into hiding in the Secret Annex along with the Van Pels family (Van Daan in Anne's diary).	<b>4<sup>th</sup> August</b> The Secret Annex is raided by the security police after an anonymous tip off. All the occupants were sent to Westerbork transit camp. <b>3<sup>rd</sup> September</b> The occupants of the Secret Annex are transported to Auschwitz-Birkenau on the last train to leave Westerbork. <b>October</b> Anne and Margot are transported from Auschwitz-Birkenau to Bergen-Belsen.	<b>February/March</b> Anne and Margot both die of typhus. Of the eight people who went into hiding in the Secret Annex, only Anne's father, Otto Frank, survived the war. <b>15<sup>th</sup> April</b> Bergen-Belsen is liberated by British troops.	<b>25<sup>th</sup> June</b> Anne's diary is first published in Dutch. It has since been translated into 50 languages and is one of the world's most popular books.
